Georgia or "Dixie" as she is known on the farm was one of our first dexters and remains as the herd matriarch. Georgia tends more to the dairy type and carries very nice length and top line. She is a very heavy milker and we use her as our house milk cow during the first 2 months of her lactation as she produces more than her calves can handle. She will milk for our use during this time in excess of 2.0 gallons with calf on her side. Georgia is not without fault, in particular her rear udder attachment, median suspensory ligament and teat size. With judicious sire selection for Georgia (R.H. Big Mac and Lucifer of Knotting) we have been able to realize significant improvement in Georgia's offspring on these characteristics and carry through many of her very good traits.
